Job Description

Dresden International School seeks a fully qualified part-time Pre-School Educator to support our educational and After School Care programmes at our Preschool campus located at Goethealle 18, Dresden-Blasewitz.

You will work as part of our Teaching and After School Care teams, providing supervision and the teaching and learning programme of students. You will be responsible for supporting students within both programmes.

This is a part-time 50% position - 20 hours per week (daily hours are Monday to Friday from 14:00 to 18:00). Further opportunities for additional cover teaching may also be possible.

You will be responsible for the educational development and care of preschool children (ages 1-5 years) in accordance with the DIS Mission Statement and Philosophy, and objectives.

Student Needs

- Provide supervision and learning opportunities to all children in the employee's care and attend to the individual needs of each child.
- Interact positively with students whilst supervising a range of student activities in both indoor and outdoor areas.



Planning, Teaching & Assessment

In collaboration with the educational and school care team, develop authentic and engaging learning
experiences to develop children's conceptual understanding with goals linked to objectives that
include inquiry and exploration, opportunities for gross- and fine-motor development; facilitate a
rich and varied language experiences; and; opportunities for children to interact and express
themselves verbally and nonverbally.

The Learning Environment

- Create and maintain a respectful, calm and caring climate.
- Ensure proper hygiene procedures are practised.
- Create an environment that promotes multi-sensory and play-based learning.
- Maintain the learning spaces allocated for school care and ensure that they are kept neat and tidy.

Parent Relations

- Develop and maintain regular and respectful communication with parents, including issues specifically related to school care.
- Deliver only the required information from the educators to parents by guiding parents to communicate with their child's homeroom educator.
- Keep accurate records of and support student sign-out procedures when students leave school care.
- Check incoming parents and visitors for ID and assist with the management of visitor passes.

- Develop and maintain standards of professionalism, including confidentiality.
- Show mutual respect in caring for other members of the DIS community.
- Communicate respectfully and effectively with others.
- Resolve problems and/or disagreements in a respectful and timely manner.
