




















## Grade 3A and B School Supply List 2018-2019



**In addition to the following supplies, new students need to bring a deposit of 5€ for their math template.** Those children who returned their math template last year do not need to bring the money.

Daily Routine supplies	
<p>1 DIS blue bag Available in the school front office/reception. Cost 5,00€ (For homework, notes, and letters to be sent home) – <i>to be paid to the PYP office. If your child has one already, you don't have to buy a new one.</i></p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"></p> <p>1 water bottle There is a <u>water only</u> policy. Do not send juice, sugared drinks with your child. <u><i>They will be asked to put it away and save it for the end of the day if they bring it to school.</i></u></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"></p> <p>1 snack box Please make sure your child has a <i>healthy snack</i>. This means NO sweets, incl. chocolate, gummy bears, Hanuta, Knoppers, cookies, etc. <u><i>If students bring these for snack, they will not be allowed to eat them.</i></u></p>
<p>1 lunch bag (for children who do not eat school hot lunch)</p>	
<p><b>Lunch:</b> We recommend you order a hot school lunch with Gourmetta. Order forms available in the school office. Please note that home lunches <u>must</u> be cold lunches. We have no means of heating up food from home.</p>	
<p>Please provide your child with appropriate rain gear when weather required (we will still have recess and outside play time) <i>raincoat, rain boots</i> - NO UMBRELLAS</p>	

Miscellaneous	
<p>1 pair of indoor house shoes (They must have a closed heel or strap)</p>	
<p>3 boxes of tissues (To share in classroom)</p>	
<p>3 rolls of paper towel</p>	
<p>For practical and hygienic reasons, students will need to bring their own computer headsets.
